- **Dame Stephanie Shirley** was born in Germany in 1933. She grew up during WWII and eventually left Germany because she was Jewish.
- She lived as a refugee in Sutton Coldfield, which is just 30 miles from Droitwich.
- She had special permission to study Maths at a local boys school, but chose not to go to university.
- Stephanie became a Dame in 2017, after founding an all-women software company, which was valued at \$3 billion.

- **Vector Drawings** are created using shapes and lines.
- An individual element within a Vector Drawing is referred to as an **object**.
- **Layering of objects** supports the creation of more complex designs
- **Editing images** means changing the size, orientation or colour of an image, or adding text.
- The process of **duplicating** an image saves time during the editing process and allows for images to mirror each other accurately.

- **Privacy** is defined as being free from public attention.
- Privacy is important because it prevents personal information being shared to strangers. This may include: name, address, school and date of birth.

Key vocabulary and meanings

***Insert-**To add an image, shape or text to an already existing image, shape or text.

***Duplicate-**The process of copying a shape or object to save time.

***Digital Footprint** - The trail, traces or 'footprints' that people leave online. Every time you go online, you leave a footprint.

App - An **app** is a software program running on any platform. The word "**app**" is an abbreviation for "application." It's a piece of software which comes pre-installed on your device or that you install yourself.

Profile - a visual display on social media, made up of personal data and images about an individual.

Orientation - the positioning or overall layout of an item related to other items. For example, **Portrait** and **Landscape** are two common orientations found in some software applications, especially word processors.
