- We all share responsibility to look after the world we live in

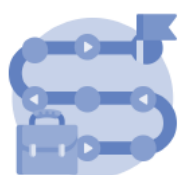

Key vocabulary and meanings

Addiction— an inability to stop and a specific habit or behaviour

***Age Restriction** - a law or guideline which shows the minimum age a person needs to be in order to use the product/service

Career— a job that someone chooses to do for a long period of time

Deforestation - cutting down forest and animal habitats in order to make way for farmland or urban use

***Fake news** - any form of journalism that aims to mislead readers with deliberately incorrect information

Fossil fuels— substances such as oil, coal and natural gas

Independence - being able to do things without the help of other people

Responsibility- being trusted with doing something important

Salary- an amount of money that someone is paid to do a job

***Stereotype** - ideas about certain groups of people that are often incorrect
