RELATIONSHIIPS

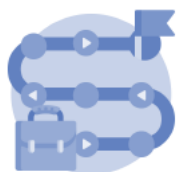
- An unhealthy relationship can show these behaviours: intensity, jealousy, guilting and betrayal.
- Anti-bullying week is held in the 3rd week of November every year.
- Anti-bullying week aims to raise awareness of the bullying of children and young people.
- 1 in 5 children aged 10 –15 experience cyber bullying.
- There are good and bad secrets.
- There are times when it is right to 'share a secret'.
- Most stereotypes are negative and should be challenged.
- Listening and responding respectfully to a wide range of people is important.
- When challenging others' points of view, this should be done with respect and in a constructive manner.

COMMUNITY (6Rs)

- Our 6Rs can be transferred to our community.
- Asking for help is being *resourceful* and can help us to resist peer pressure.
- Looking after the environment is the *responsibility* of everyone in the community.
- *Reflecting* on your own achievements, strengths and areas for improvements, is important for setting high aspirations and goals.
- Habits can be good and bad, but often hard to change.
- To make an informed choice, you can list the positives and negatives before making a decision.

CAREERS

- When working, you can either be paid a salary or a wage.
- A salary is a fixed amount each month, regardless of how many hours you work.
- A wage is where you are paid a set amount for each hour you work.
- Some professions will earn a wage, and some will earn a salary.
- On average, a train driver will earn £41k a year.
