- Droitwich has seen a lot of new homes being built recently and this has led to concerns regarding amenities, traffic congestion and school places.
- Droitwich is the most densely populated area in the Wychavon district. The average persons to square mile in Droitwich South West is 9970— more than any other area.
- **The NHS Act**, brought before parliament in 1946, was created with the aim to provide universal and free benefits to all those in need. It is an example of a state welfare system that looks after people from 'the cradle to the grave'.

- The UK is ranked 16th in terms of their carbon footprint, contributing 1.1% of the world's global emissions. However, China alone produced 28% and was responsible for almost two-thirds of the growth in emissions since 2000.

SEX EDUCATION

- **Sexual Intercourse** - The process where the male and female reproductive organs meet so that fertilisation can take place.
- **Fertilisation** - The process where the sperm cell and egg cell fuse (join together) to form an embryo.
- **Egg cells** are designed for purpose as they are large and can carry a lot of food for the embryo.
- **Sperm cells** are designed for purpose as they are small and have long tails to help them swim to the egg.
- **Birth Control** refers to things you can do to reduce the chances of pregnancy. This can include abstinence and the use of contraception.
- **Contraception** can also be a way of reducing the chance of getting STIs.
- The cleaning of genitals is a very important part of washing as infections can occur if neglected.

RELATIONSHIPS

- Many young pupils feel peer pressured into relationships or acting in a particular way. This can affect future relationships.

- Cases of anxiety and depression in young children are on the rise especially in boys. There are increased issues with negative body image amongst young children.
- The age of consent to any form of sexual activity is 16 for both men and women regardless of gender or sexual orientation.
- It is an offence for anyone to have any sexual activity with a person under the age of 16.
- Coercive or controlling behaviour within an intimate or family relationship was established as a criminal offence in the Serious Crime Act 2015, and came into force on **29 December 2015**. It listed 11 offences that related to these coercive behaviours

Key vocabulary and meanings

STIs— This acronym stands for Sexually Transmitted Infections. These are infections that can be caught through intercourse.

Contraception (often referred to as *birth control*) prevents pregnancy by interfering with the normal process of ovulation, fertilization, and implantation.

Pregnancy is the term used to describe the period in which a foetus develops inside a woman's womb or uterus. Pregnancy usually lasts about 40 weeks, or just over 9 months .

Coercion is the practice of persuading someone to do something by using force or threats. Some one who displays coercion traits is being **coercive**.

Body Image refers to a person's emotional attitudes, beliefs, and perceptions of their own body.

Community- a group of people living together and practising common ownership.

NHS— an acronym for the National Health Service.

Developing country— a poor, agricultural country that is seeking to become more advanced economically and socially.

Carbon footprint- the amount of carbon dioxide released into the atmosphere as a result of the activities of a particular individual, organisation, or community.

Abstinence - not take part in something, typically drinking alcohol or having sex
