What is it?

CENTURY is an online platform using AI (Artificial Intelligence) to personalise learning to your child's needs so they see the right content at the right time for them. The content has been created by Century's team of outstanding, experienced teachers.

You learn on CENTURY by completing bite-sized lessons called [nuggets](#). Each nugget on CENTURY contains a learning video and slideshow, followed by questions to test knowledge.

There are also [diagnostics](#) which help assess how well children know a topic to start with. Based on the results, CENTURY can then recommend the best nuggets for your child to learn.

Logging into Century

Type into your browser bar: app.century.tech/login (or search for Century Tech log in)

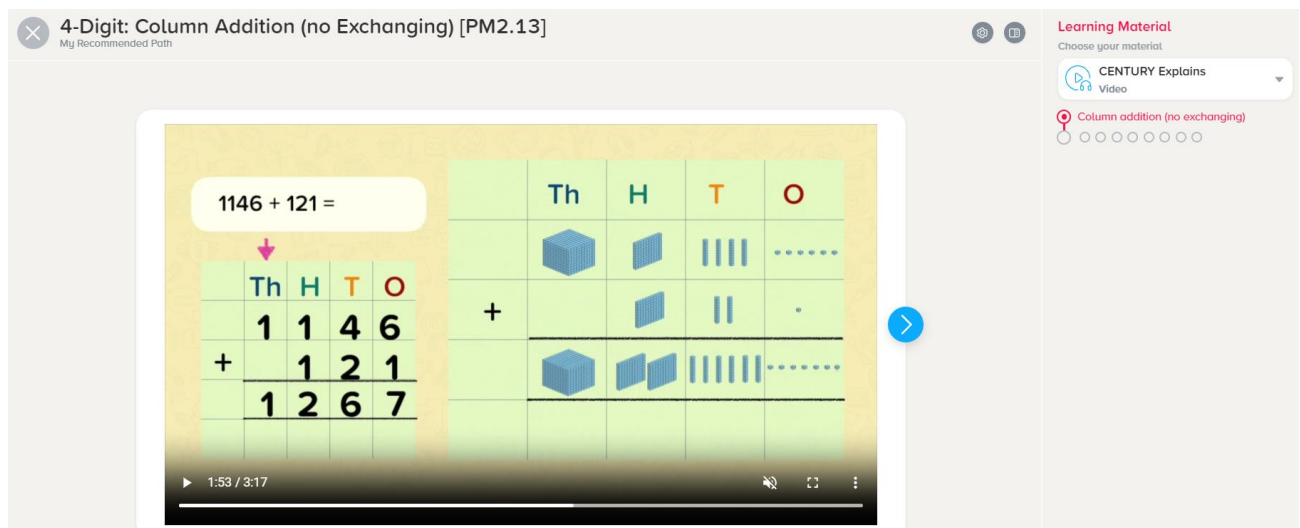

Homework

Once logged in, your child's 'Recommended Path' will appear. This will display the nuggets that Century suggest for your child to do next. To show only specific subjects, click the dots in the top right-hand corner.



Once logged in, children must watch the video first showing the method. This explains exactly what your child needs to do so it is important that they watch this carefully, more than once if needed. Please note that if your child is completing a 'diagnostic' nugget, there will be no video as it will just be assessing what your child does and does not know.



Children can also refer to the 'Remember card' which again will help support your child in completing the questions. This can be found by clicking the arrow under 'Learning Materials'. Once children are ready to attempt the questions, they can click the blue 'next' arrow.

Children will have to use a pencil and paper (or a whiteboard) to work out the answer to the question. Once they have calculated the answer, they must carefully type it into the answer box and then click 'Submit answer'.
