Subject	Task	Success Criteria
English	Create an information booklet about your country.	Must: Have the following headings as a minimum: Location, Weather and Things to Do. Should: Ensure the information booklet is attractive to look at. Could: Use the computer to create your booklet.
Maths	Research the currency of your country.	Must: Find out the currency's name and what the exchange rate is. Should: Create a currency converter table. Could: Create a birthday wish list, and calculate how much the items would cost, in your country's currency. <i>For example, how many dollars would an X-Box be in America?</i>
History	Research historical events 'through the decades' for your country.	Must: Find out facts on a topic for at least 5 decades. <i>For example, 1960s, 1970s, 1980s, 2000s, 2010s.</i> Should: Present these facts in an interesting way with diagrams, drawings or examples. Could: Predict what might happen in the 2050s decade!
Geography	Research the major biome for your country. <i>You can request a biome map from your teacher to help.</i>	Must: Explain the main biome for that country. Should: Draw the biome. Could: Instead of drawing the biome, create a biome in a box. (You can google lots of ideas)
Music	Research our country's National Anthem.	Must: Write out the national anthem and decorate the page. Should: Explain when it is used and what it means to them. Could: Perform the national anthem by using your voice or an instrument.
Art	Draw a landscape or a well-known building from your country.	Must: Be at least A4 in size with a brief description attached. Should: Represent the country's style. (Art work from that country may help) Could: Be 3D or use a range of media (collage, pottery, paper, textiles, pen, pencils, paint etc.)
DT	Make some food that originates from your country.	Must: Include the recipe. Should: Provide evidence through photographs or by bringing the final product in. Could: Create a 3 course meal for your family to enjoy!



Science	Research a plant or animal native to your country and explain how it has adapted to its environment.	Must: Draw an image of your animal or plant and label the adaptations Should: Explain how the adaptations help it to survive. Could: Consider how it could change if its environment changed.
PE	Research a sport that originates or is important to that country.	Must: Explain the rules of the sport and why it's important to them. Should: Prepare a lesson to teach others how to play that sport. Could: Deliver the lesson to the class or to family/friends. (You could record this!)
R&W	Explore the main religions for your country.	Must: Explain the main religions and the key principles of these. Should: Present it in a memorable way. Could: Consider how this may affect tourists visiting the country.
PSHE	Research the culture and customs of your country.	Must: Explain 3 different customs that represent your country's culture. Should: Present this information in a memorable way. Could: Choose 1 custom and debate whether you agree with it or not. Give reasons for your answer.
Language	Research the language of your country.	Must: Find basic greetings. For example: hello, goodbye, thank you, my name is.. Should: Present it in a creative way that shows the English translation. Could: Record yourselves speaking the key words. Could you record a mini conversation with a member of your family/friend?
