Dear Parent/Carers,

Our Pupil Learning Discussions are due to take place on **Wednesday 25th February 4.00pm – 7.00pm** and **Wednesday 4th March 3.10pm – 6.00pm**, with your child's teacher of Maths and English.

Once again, we are offering our parents a blended approach by providing the opportunity to attend a virtual appointment via our School Cloud online platform on **Wednesday 25th February 4.00pm – 7.00pm** or alternatively to attend a face to face appointment, in school, on **Wednesday 4th March 3.10pm – 6.00pm**. Please be aware that some nights may be more popular than others and we encourage you to book early, if you have a particular preference, as appointments are booked on a first come first served basis, using the online system.

Whichever evening you attend, our aim is for the conversation between you, your child, and their teacher to focus on their progress, attainment, and next steps in learning, as well as how they have settled back into school this term. We warmly encourage your child to come along so they can take part in the discussion and proudly share their learning in their Maths and English books. As a school, we truly value these opportunities to talk with you about your child's learning and everyday life at Westacre. These meetings are an important part of the partnership between home and school, and our staff greatly appreciate the chance to meet with you and celebrate your child's achievements.

Regardless of whether you would like to attend a face-to-face appointment or attend online, our School Cloud booking system will allow you to select a suitable appointment time and you will receive an email confirming your appointment. Appointments can be made with your **child's Maths and English teacher** and will be 10 minutes long.

If your child is in 7AM, both Miss Majewska and Mrs Page will be in the meeting together as your child's Maths and English teachers. This will also apply to 5JR with Mrs Bird and Mrs Humphries, as well as 6WB with Mrs West and Mrs Bennett. If your child is in a small group taught by Mrs Coldrick in Year 5 or Miss Gillson in Year 6, **these are the teachers to book your appointment with on this occasion.**

If you are attending online, this will be conducted via video link, which will require the use of a smart phone or another webcam and microphone enabled device. Whichever appointment you choose, both will allow for personalised and individual conversations between school and home regarding your child's learning. Following your appointment with your child's teacher, if you feel you require additional time then please do contact our school office.

The appointment system will open from **7.30pm on Tuesday 10th February**. They will then close at **4.00pm on Tuesday 24th February** for the virtual appointments and **4.00pm on Tuesday 3rd March** for the face-to-face appointments. All appointments should be booked 24 hours prior to the actual evening, to ensure staff have all the information they need to discuss your child's learning with you. There is an option within the appointments system for you to let us know that you are unable to participate in the evening and, should this be the case, we would be grateful if you could notify us by using this option.
