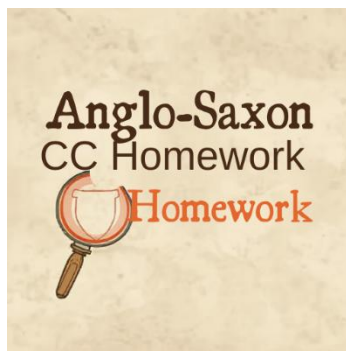




Year 5 CC Homework: Detectives Anglo-Saxons

Your homework this term is based on your Creative Curriculum topic of Detectives. As we work through our lessons, you will learn more about this topic, however you will need to do some independent research to complete your homework. **Select 2 of the tasks below.**

SCIENCE What materials would the Anglo-Saxons have used in their settlements? Create a list of materials and their properties. How have the materials we use now changed? Be creative in your presentation	PE What games would the Anglo-Saxons have played? Devise a new game which Anglo-Saxon children would have enjoyed playing.	GEOGRAPHY Produce a map showing the areas Anglo-Saxons came from – Consider where they started and settled in the UK or produce a 3D map of the seven Anglo-Saxon kingdoms in England.
RELIGION & WORLDVIEWS The Anglo-Saxons had a set of beliefs and several gods. Research and create a guide to at least 3 of them – which type of gods were they and what was their importance?	MUSIC Research a typical Anglo-Saxon musical instrument. What were they made from and how were they played? Then, create an instrument of your own.	COMPUTING Create a presentation about an Anglo-Saxon ruler or early King/Queen of Britain. This can be presented as a PowerPoint, Vlog or via another media.
HISTORY Where do the Anglo-Saxons fit into British history? Devise a timeline which shows their place chronologically.	ENGLISH Write a detective story of your own or research, and create a fact file for, a famous fictional detective. Remember to include your Year 5 writing skills!	MATHS Research a typical Anglo-Saxon meal. Adapt the ingredients so your menu will feed 15 people. How much food will you need to feed them all? Be creative in your presentation.
D.T. Design and create a model of an Anglo-Saxon house using natural resources (straw, sticks etc.) Keep it to the size of a cereal box!	FOOD TECHNOLOGY Research and create a list of foods grown and cooked by Anglo-Saxons. Compare it to some of the foods we grow and cook in the U.K. today. Include similarities and differences in your work.	ART Create your own artistic Anglo-Saxon piece using the traditional range of colours. You can do this as creatively as you like (e.g. jewellery, drawing, painting)
