YEAR SIX SATS INFORMATION SESSIONS

Dear Parents/Carers,

As we start the Spring term and look towards the remainder of the school year, Key Stage 2 Statutory Assessment Tests (SATS) are appearing on the horizon.

The key stage 2 SATS are timetabled from Monday 11th May to Thursday 14th May 2026.

Monday 11 th May 2026	English grammar, punctuation and spelling papers 1 and 2
Tuesday 12 th May 2026	English reading
Wednesday 13 th May 2026	Mathematics papers 1 and 2
Thursday 14 th May 2026	Mathematics paper 3

With this in mind, we encourage all parents/carers to attend one of our SATS information sessions, along with their child, in order to gather all of the information you should need.

These sessions will take place on **Wednesday 28th January 2:00-2:50pm** and **6:00-7:00pm**. Please indicate on Arbor which session you wish to attend (they are repeated, so attendance at both is not required). It will be beneficial for your children to also attend and hear the information, and therefore they will join you in the hall for the afternoon session.

Mr McMullen (Mathematics Lead), Mrs Murray (English Lead), Mrs Coldrick (SENCo), Mrs Humphries (KS2 Lead) along with myself as Head of Year will be present to explain what happens during SATS week, give example resources, and to answer any questions you may have. Alongside the subject leads, year 6 class teachers will also be present to answer questions during the evening session.

As part of our on-going preparation towards KS2 assessments, our staff will continue to support your children through a range of strategies to achieve their best possible outcomes. For some children, this may include working with other teachers in bespoke groups during their usual lessons.

We recognise that SATs tests are a snapshot of your child on one particular day and in one particular assessment, they do not assess all of what makes your child special and unique. All of the special talents and skills which your child has are just as important and are equally celebrated by us at Westacre.
