Educational Day – Greek Day

Dear Parents/Carers,

To immerse the children in their Ancient Greek topic, we have planned an Ancient Greek Day on **Friday 21st November**. The purpose of this day is to explore the culture, traditions and main events of the Ancient Greek history. The children will take part in the following investigations/activities:

1. Greek myths and legends (Drama and Oracy focus)
2. What made Greek mosaics so influential?
3. What foods might the Ancient Greeks have eaten? (food tasting)
4. The Ancient Greeks – Research and presentation

This day supports our Curriculum Drivers. *Diversity*: By understanding the different cultures that live in Worcestershire – Greek. *Aspirations*: By sharing possible career paths such as food technicians, chefs, historians, being part of the Olympics or working in travel and tourism. *Communication*: Through role-play, script writing and discussions.

Children are invited to dress up in something related to Ancient Greece. This could be a Greek God or Goddess or a character from a Greek Myth. You do not have to spend money on a costume. This is only a small aspect of the day. There are also Toga tutorials online using a bed sheet and some rope.
