Dear Parent/Carers,

Anti-Bullying Week starts on Monday 10th November. Throughout the week we will be discussing what we can do as a school, to be ourselves, respect others and be free from bullying.



The week will kick off with Odd Socks Day on Monday 10th, with adults and children being encouraged to wear odd socks to celebrate what makes us all unique.



On Wednesday 12th November, we will be participating in Positive Noticing Day. Positive Noticing is simple, practical and highly effective. The impact of positive noticing is both immediate and long-lasting. It helps build self-esteem and confidence in children. At the start of the week, children will bring home a blank label, which parents and carers are

encouraged to write positive comments on about their child. Children will bring the label back into school, where their friends and teachers can add the positive things they have 'noticed' about that child. During wellbeing time, classes will reflect on the positive things they have noticed about each other and how that has made them feel.



On Friday 14th November we will be supporting Children in Need. To raise money for this charity, we will be having a non-uniform day on Friday 14th November. We ask that clothing and footwear is appropriate for school. PE lessons will continue as normal, so any children that do have PE that day can still wear non-uniform, but this should be suitable for physical activity.
