Dear Parent/Carer,

As part of their Religion and Worldviews topic of investigating how Christians celebrate Christmas, Year Six will be visiting Worcester Cathedral. **The cost will be £12.57 for each child via Arbor**; this includes coach fare, a guided tour of the cathedral, three guided workshops focusing on the meaning of Christmas and the nativity and a visit to the fantastic festive Christmas tree exhibition.

Please support us by returning your payment and consent by **Tuesday 2nd December**. Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient funds, the trip may need to be cancelled. Should this be the case, all parents will be notified, and refunds will be given to parents who have already paid.

The coach will leave school at 9.15 am and will return at approximately 2.30pm. Children will need to bring a packed lunch to school as usual and can also bring in a non-fizzy drink and snack in a small bag.

Children will need to wear full school uniform (school shirts, ties, jumpers and their normal smart shoe shoes) on this day and a warm, waterproof coat as it can be chilly inside the main cathedral building at this time of year.

If you wish your child to attend this event, please give consent and make the payment on Arbor. By giving permission, you are also agreeing that medical and dental treatment may be given to your child if necessary, including the administration of a general anaesthetic and to surgical operations in the case of emergency, in accordance with the recommendation of a qualified medical practitioner. Should this not be the case, please contact the school prior to the trip.

Please ensure that, if your child requires any form of medication (including inhalers), they have it in school with them, and that the necessary paperwork has been returned to school for the administration of it.
