Dear Parents/ Carers,

Below I have put together an overview of the exciting plans we have in place.

WB: Monday 6th July – Children are welcome to wear their leavers' hoody in replace of their school jumper for the last 2 weeks of term.

WB: Monday 13th July – Children are welcome to bring in an old shirt to get 'signed' by other children as a memento. Please also send in suitable pens for the children to use on their shirt.

Wednesday 15th July

End of Year Assembly 09:00 – 10:30. Parents/Carers are invited into school for a chance to celebrate the children's time at Westacre. **This is limited to two visitors per family due to fire regulations.**

Thursday 16th July

Leaver's Lunch and Party Through consultation with the children, the Leaver's Lunch will be a choice of hotdogs and chips! There will be a vegetarian option available. This is payable in the usual way and is optional – children can of course still bring a packed lunch. Please sign up to this on Arbor, to support the kitchen in reducing wastage by Monday 6th July.

End of Year Disco 17:00 – 18:30. This is not like any ordinary disco, as we have organised a *silent disco* for the children to enjoy! Permission and payment needs to be given on Arbor. Entry to the disco is £3 and includes a snack and a drink.

Friday 17th July

West Midland Safari Park 08:25 – 14:55. Children will need to bring a packed lunch to school and can also bring in a non-fizzy drink and snack. If your child receives a free school lunch, then this may still be provided, but must be selected on Arbor. Children will not need to wear school uniform on this day, but a waterproof jacket may be advisable as will a sensible pair of shoes e.g. trainers. Crocs/flipflops are not permitted to be worn on the rides. Children may bring money to spend but please keep this to a reasonable amount as they will be responsible for this. Children cannot take mobile phones, in line with our usual school policies and procedures.
