Year 7 Commandery Visit

Dear Parent/Guardian,

As part of their Conflict topic, Year 7 will be visiting The Commandery Museum in Worcester on the following days –

7LC & 7RM – Wednesday 26th November
7BM & 7AM – Thursday 27th November
7LV – Friday 28th November

The cost will be **£14.10** for each child; this includes coach fare and two guided workshops at The Commandery to appreciate the historic aspects of the city as part of the English Civil War. We believe that the trip will help promote our History and Geography curricula in Year 7 with a focus on the importance of Fort Royal to the war, using maps to look at its features. We shall also be studying how local men prepared for battle – either on the Parliamentary side or Royalists! There will also be a self-guided session of the Commandery and its exhibits.

Please support us by returning your payment and consent by Friday 14th November. Please be aware that if we do not receive sufficient funds, the trip may need to be cancelled. Should this be the case, all parents will be notified and refunds will be given to parents who have already paid.

The coach will leave school at 9:30am and will return at approximately 2.30pm.
